Selectboard Decision on Sewer Bond Payment

On Tuesday, Sept. 17 Glover voters will go to the polls to vote yes or no on a \$2,800,000 bond to extend the town sewer system to the homes and camps around Lake Parker.

At the end of the Glover selectboard meeting on Sept. 12, after hearing the opinions expressed at the public meeting and taking into consideration input submitted by email or other personal communications, the selectboard voted unanimously to share the anticipated \$1,540,000 debt according to the formula 50% Lake Parker sewer users and 50% all Glover property tax payers.

This is conditional on a positive vote on the sewer bond, on an acceptable financing offer from

USDA Rural Development, and on final approval of the sewer extension project.

We hope that USDA will offer Glover a \$2,800,000 package that includes a \$1,260,000 grant and a \$1,540,000 loan at 3% over 30 years. We encourage Glover voters to vote on Sept. 17, between the hours of 10AM and 7PM, and to approve the bond issue.
