Our committee is looking to see if our membership has an interest in constructing and launching a loon nesting raft this spring, in conjunction with the Vermont Loon Conservation Project, VT Center for Eco Studies (Eric Hanson). Mr. Hanson believes that since Parker has had a pair of loons for the past several years, and that on at least one occasion had eggs in a nest, the loons may well be successful if they had a safer place to nest.
