Dear Lake Parker Neighbors:

Please come to a meeting on Thursday evening, August 27th, at 8:00 p.m. in the church vestry at West Glover to help form a Lake Parker Association, similar to the ones in existence at Lake Dunmore, Caspian Lake, Shadow Lake, and Willeoughby Lake.

The broad purpose of such an association here would be to preserve the fine living and vacation environment which has made our lake so desirable over the past fifty years.

The formation of such an association in West Glover has been discussed for a good many years, and on August 13 a cross section of our community met and agreed that such an organization here would be desirable and useful. It would provide a means for discussing and resolving matters of mutual concern such as Fishing, Safety, Water Pollution, Land Use, Conservation etc. in this area.

Interstate 91 is swiftly building toward us from North and South, and soon thousands of people will be putting further pressure on this area's facilities. Change will come, but such an Association could be an important influence in maintaining and in preserving the beauty and quality of our surroundings.

Plans for an Association are under way. You as a property holder have a vital interest in these plans.
