

**LAKE PARKER ASSOCIATION  
MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE REPORT  
Fiscal Year 2024 through June 2025**

Committee activities for this period included keeping abreast of property transfers around the lake, greeting new owners, encouraging their membership in the Association and providing them a Lake Parker Resource Guide.

During 2024 through June of this year, a total of 5 lakefront properties changed hands: 2 on Access Lane and 1 each on Damon Lane, Monette Place and Parker Road. In addition, several other properties were sold that were off-lake and within the Lake Parker watershed.

In 2024 LPA had a total of 70 memberships, which included 68 full memberships and 2 associate members. These memberships were comprised of:

- 65 lakeshore (or directly adjacent to the lake) property owners
- 3 off-lake households within the watershed
- 2 qualifying for Associate memberships

We continue to be on track for maintaining about the same number of memberships for FY2025 as in past years. While the number of memberships has remained relatively steady for the past several years, our objective continues to be increasing our membership rolls to include all property owners who have a vested interest in the health and welfare of Lake Parker and its environs.

LPA is offering a Visitor's Guide that our members can provide to their guests/renters. This bi-fold pamphlet highlights information on boating, fishing, local ordinances, eco-friendly practices and where to find basic supplies and essential services in the immediate area.
